Dilatation of the central canal YES


central canal dilatation and surrounding spinal cord oedema in C3 region

Mucoid material in **BOTH** tympanic bullae (right more than left)









This dog was **6.1 years old** at the time of scanning. Using the informal CKCS classification scheme the grade of **A** would be attributed to this individual. This dog is mildly affected and is over 6 years of age and this should be taken into account when making breeding decisions.
